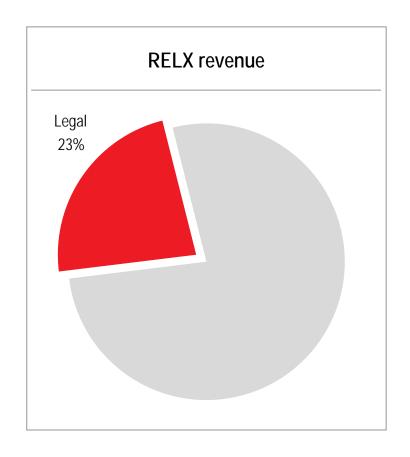

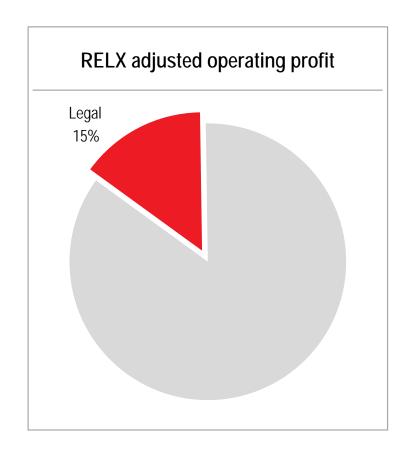

# Legal position within RELX H1 2021

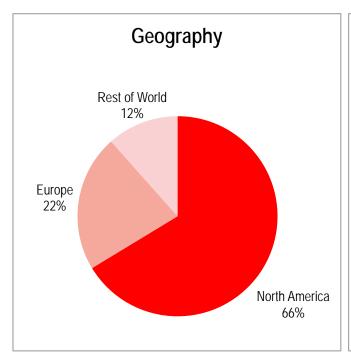


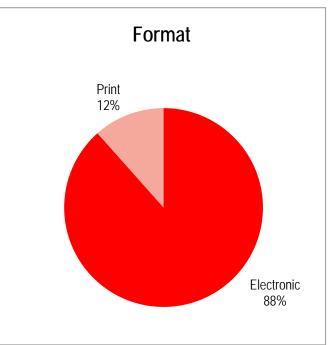


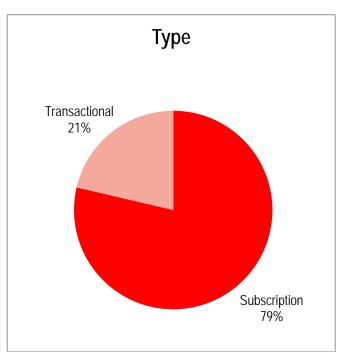
• LTM Legal revenues for June 2021: £1.6bn (\$2.2bn)



# Legal revenue by type H1 2021



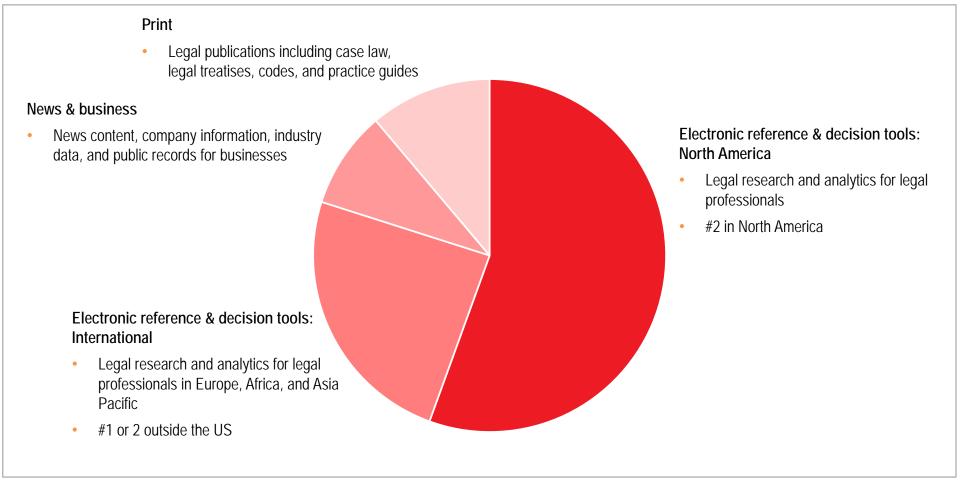

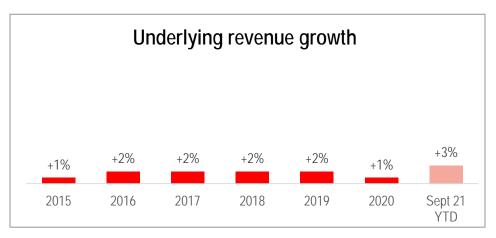


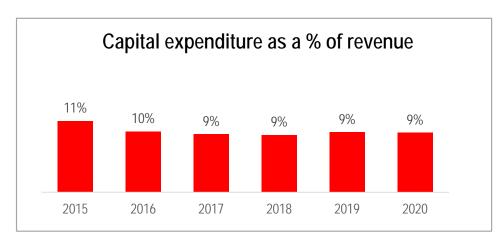
# Legal revenue by segment H1 2021

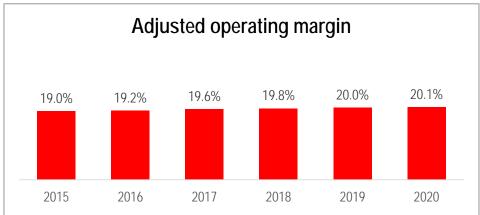


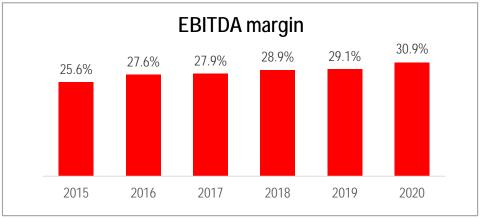

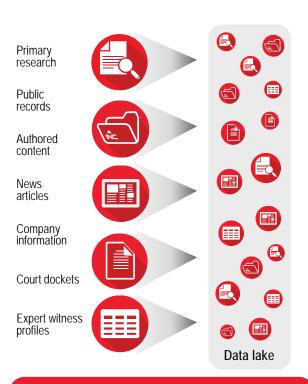
## Large law customer spend example (AmLaw top 20)

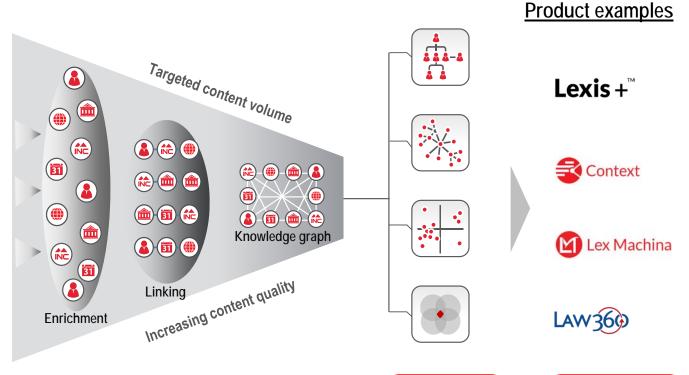


# Leveraging global scale and technology

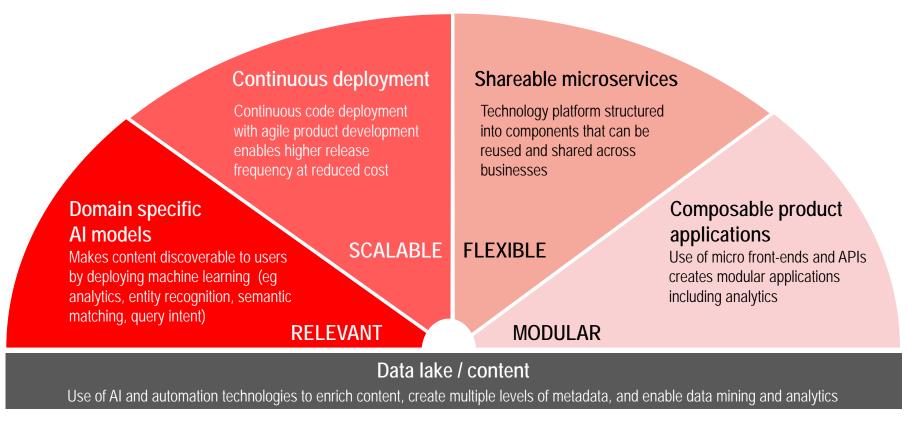

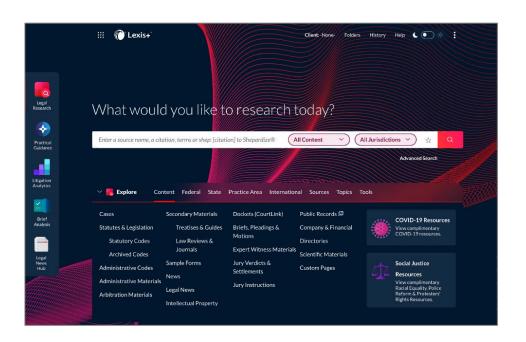

- Enhanced Search: Powered by machine learning and new features including Search Tree, Missing and Must Include, and expanded Search Term Maps
- Modern Design: Bold interface that establishes a clear visual hierarchy, aligned with legal professional workflow

#### **Customer**

Attorney at a large US law firm beginning a new matter with a client responding to an employment class action lawsuit

### **Key questions**

- How should the client plan for this matter (eg outcomes and durations)?
- Who should the client engage as their expert witness?
- How should the team optimize their strategy against opposing counsel?

#### LexisNexis products and use cases

- Litigation Analytics: Leverage judge analytics to anticipate case timelines and outcomes based on prior case history and build case strategy
- Context: Find strong witness for client's matter based on witness analytics, including comparison of witnesses and analysis of prior testimony outcomes
- Brief Analysis: Conduct a smart review of legal documents, including opposing counsel arguments, for case and guidance recommendations

### **Customer**

· Associate at a major law firm, who focuses on Mergers and Acquisitions, working on a buy-side merger

### **Key questions**

- What is the market standard on indemnification clauses for deals similar to the client's potential merger?
- How do prior deals structure and define them?

### LexisNexis products and use cases

- Market Standards
- Identify similar deals (eg based on industry) from a database of 37,000 publicly filed deals
- Extract and analyse over 150 key deal terms
- Access underlying deal documents to find precedent language and case examples for drafting
